



# GIRLS DRESS CODE REQUIREMENTS

## 2011-2012

It is expected that Holland Hall students will be neat, clean and appropriate in their dress on campus or when participating in a school function off campus. This includes shirts tucked in, shoes tied and all dress code requirements adhered to. In addition, the following are not permitted at Holland Hall: visible tattoos; body piercing, other than ears; or non-recognizable human hair color. Hats are not permitted to be worn in any building on campus.

Shirts	White pique knit button-up blouse, short or long sleeved with Holland Hall logo. Only available through C & J School Uniforms.  PreSchool Only: White blouse with blue piping (short or long sleeves) to be worn with PreSchool jumper ONLY.	Cardinal short sleeved collared pique knit shirt with embroidered Holland Hall current logo (no Crest) on left chest through C & J School Uniforms.  Note: Only plain white short sleeved t-shirt may be worn under uniform shirt.	Three quarter length sleeve open collar blouse in solid white or blue through C & J School Uniforms, or <b>Oxford button-down shirt (short or long sleeves)</b> in solid white, pastel blue, pastel yellow or pastel pink.  <b>Only plain white undergarments</b> or plain white long sleeved undershirt may be worn under blouse.
Jumpers/Skirts/Skortts	Plaid jumper or plaid skort through C & J School Uniforms.  PreSchool jumper available through C & J School Uniforms only. (No Bell-bottoms, hip-huggers, stitched on pockets, or slits in seams permitted.) Sweatshirts/Outerwear	Any sweatshirt with an official Holland Hall logo. (Available at the Primary School front entry kiosk or C & J School Uniforms.) All must be worn over pique knit uniform blouse.  <u>Hoodies are not permitted.</u>	Any approved sweatshirt with an official Holland Hall logo. (Available from C & J School Uniforms.) Shoes	Any UNADORNED tie or buckle shoe in black, navy or brown; or any UNADORNED athletic shoe in white, navy or black.  <b>Not Permitted:</b> sandals, open-toe or backless shoes; high-top shoes or boots above the ankle; shoes with heels or soles higher than 1½ inches; low back or clog-type shoes. No shoes with blinking lights.  Shoes must be appropriate for P.E.	Any good, sturdy, low heeled athletic shoe. Or, any low-heeled leather loafer or tie shoe in black or brown.  <b>Not Permitted:</b> sandals, open-toe or backless shoes; high-top shoes or boots above the ankle; shoes with heels or soles higher than 1½ inches; low back or clog-type shoes.	Any low-heeled leather loafer or tie shoe in black, brown, or tan must be worn.  <b>Not Permitted:</b> athletic shoes, <b>canvas shoes</b> , sandals, open-toe shoes, soles higher than 1½ inches, or boots.
Gym Shoes	Please be sure shoes give sufficient support for physical education activities.	<u>Gr. 4-5</u> – Two pairs, an outdoor pair and an indoor pair. The indoor pair should have white soles in order to avoid marking the gym floor. <u>Grades 4-5</u> who wear athletic shoes to school may also use them for their outdoor P.E. shoes. White athletic socks. Please be sure athletic shoes give sufficient support.	Athletic shoes for gym use should have white soles to avoid marking the gym floor.
